

Fuller / Foster Building

715-723 S. Harbor Boulevard

Brick Commercial

Status: Significant Property



This one-story brick commercial building differs in form and decoration from others of the type in Fullerton: the building is designed without a parapet; there is a selective use of two colors of brick; and the cast concrete rosettes near the roofline are a more refined embellishment.

The building was apparently constructed as a commercial real estate venture. The property was quickly sold after the building's completion, and eventually, owned by businessman Sam Fuller from 1926 to 1945 and by contractor Albert Foster from 1945 to the mid-1960s. Designed with five separate tenant spaces, there have been an array of businesses occupying the building over the years, but none has stayed for any length of time.

There is no indication of major alterations to the exterior, although presently, large signs hide transom windows along the building's front façade.
